I understand and agree to cooperate with all regulations and procedures, and I waive any claims against Camp Fire, partnering organizations, volunteers and paid staff, except for claims arising from gross negligence or willful acts of the organization or its agents that may arise from participation in the activities of the organization.

I understand that I will be notified as soon as possible in case of any emergency, unusual illness or injury affecting my child. In the event I cannot be reached, I hereby authorize the alternate contact people to act on my behalf, and authorize the camp to contact a physician to provide whatever medical or surgical treatment is necessary. I accept responsibility for the cost of such medical treatments. I have provided a complete picture of my child's physical, emotional and mental health, including all medications, on this registration form, and will provide (on the first day of camp) updated health information on the form provided by Camp Fire. I will assure that my child will not bring valuables, money, electronic items, weapons, alcohol or illegal drugs to camp. I will monitor my child's use and distribution of any photos taken at camp to assure that they are not used inappropriately nor posted on the Internet. In the event that my child (or ward) is photographed, filmed or recorded while participating in Camp Fire activities, Camp Fire or other partnering organization approved by Camp Fire may use the photo, film or recording for publicity, promotional or instructional purposes.
